



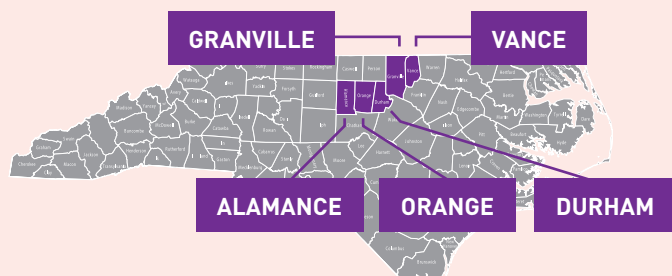

What is NC InCK?

The NC InCK goal: Improve the health and well-being of youth and families insured by Medicaid or Health Choice by creating a new way to care for children and youth that brings together healthcare, schools, and other community organizations.

Who is involved in NC InCK:

Leaders from healthcare (UNC & Duke), communities, and the state government are teaming up with families and youth to do this exciting work.

What is the NC InCK Family Council?



Our Goal: Ensure that our work is child and family-led.



Who is on the Family Council: Caregivers of Medicaid or CHIP-insured children who want to their perspective and lived experiences to inform the NC InCK model.



How the Family Council works: The Family Council meets four times a year and works to provide feedback on NC InCK model components and brainstorm solutions to NC InCK challenges. If desired, Family Council members have the opportunity for additional engagement with NC InCK working groups, such as Early Childhood and Behavioral Health.
