What are Well-Child Visits?

Well-Child Visits are visits with a child's doctor that help with:

- Reducing visits to the Emergency Room
- Early intervention for developmental delays
- The prevention of serious illness and injury
- Caregiver success and making sure a child is ready for kindergarten

How Can I Schedule Well-Child Visits?

If you have trouble scheduling a Well-Child Visit for your child, you can use MyChart, an online healthcare platform that gives you access to your child's medical records, helps you schedule appointments, and lets you connect to their doctor.

How Can I Schedule Transportation to Well-Child Visits?

If you have trouble with transportation, you can talk to your Medicaid provider about transportation to Well-Child Visits. Please contact your provider at least 48-hours before your upcoming appointment. You can use the contact information below.
